REFEREE'S REPORT

1) Mr. Sundin checked an opponent from behind. I assessed a minor and a GM.

Please note that:

- there are only 4 (four) penalties that should be listed in the penalty information section (the part highlighted in red in the above example). They are: MISC, GM, GRM, MAT --- these are the proper abbreviations for Misconduct, Game Misconduct, Gross Misconduct, and Match

- minor penalties and major penalties are NOT reportable and should NOT be listed in the penalties section. the GM that automatically accompanies a major would of course be listed

- when you list "GM" as a penalty, the reason for this GM is clarified by:
 - the GM code
 - the rule reference and
 - your narrative

A few examples:

- you assess a minor for CFB. This minor under our present rules automatically includes a GM. Therefore the reportable offence is the GM, not the CFB. The penalty section should NOT have CFB in it it should have GM with the appropriate code in the next column

- you assess a minor for CTH. The minor is NOT reportable, but the automatic MISC that accompanies it is reportable. You do NOT list CTH in penalties section -- you list MISC

- fight situation, 5 + GM assessed. Do NOT list FT in penalty section since it is a major which is not reportable. List GM with the appropriate code in the next column.

NOTES REGARDING THE GAME SHEET:

1. Before you sign the game sheet, check to be sure that all penalty info is correctly recorded and make any necessary corrections before handing it over the team manager.
2. Make sure all info is visible on all the copies and keep a copy (but not the top one) for yourself to complete your online GIR.
3. In the event that your GIR involves a Physical Abuse of Officials incident, this must be also faxed to the ODMHA office within 24 hours.
4. In the event that your GIR involves a Match Penalty you must phone our RIC Bruce Gray.
5. All reports must be filed on the web based ODHA Game Incident Report within 24 hrs of the infraction.
6. If the incident occurs at a tournament, you must complete the report on the back of the first copy and hand it in to a tournament official BEFORE you leave the rink as well as complete an online GIR.
